
The Transformation Leadership Program involves a series of Self-Assessment Tools (SATs) that assist an organization in developing a balanced approach to organizational transformation.



Each assessment is supported by a short instructional module.



Companies completing the program will have the tools and insight needed to design a customized roadmap for their transformation and growth.





1. Skills Review

Review your critical skills gaps coming out of the TLP including the SkillSAT that will support your organization in executing your strategic plan.

2. Employee Engagement

Select employees to participate in upskilling.

3. Personalized Plans

You and your employee will work with NGen's staff to develop a personal upskilling plan for the employees selected.

4. Training

Training is provided by existing third-party providers including academic and industrial training partners.

Leadership Teams go through the TLP at an 80% discount (\$1,500 cost) to identify key strategic gaps



Companies will select employees for upskilling based on key skills gaps identified in TLP



Employees undergo assessments of their existing skills, including an Adaptability Quotient



Employees will then go through the training per the approved upskilling plan



NGen will reimburse 80% of the cost of the upskilling program up to a maximum of \$4,000 per company upon completion of the training*



After the completion of the training, employees may once again be assessed to determine the impact of the training on their skill levels
